

SCHS Honor Societies:

*Honor Societies will require graduating seniors to remain in good standing to graduate with a chord. Membership in an honor society in the students' underclassmen year will **not** qualify the student to graduate with a chord.*

➤ **Business Honor Society**

- Blurb: The Business Honor Society will promote scholarship and encourage interest in business. There will be an induction ceremony and a community service project.

- Club Eligibility:
 - a. All candidates must be judged worthy by the chapter adviser and/or committee by meeting the standards of professional attitudes as expressed in FCPS Student Rights and Responsibilities.
 - b. Probationary members (sophomores or juniors): At the end of sophomore or junior year a student must have completed 2 credits in business courses while maintaining a 2.8 GPA at time of application with no final grades lower than "C"; however, one final grade of "D" is permissible. A final grade of 3.0 or higher in all business courses completed and a B or higher at the time of application.
 - c. Senior Membership: A total of 3 credits in FCPS Business and Information Technology subjects upon graduation with a general average of 2.8 at the time of application with no final grades lower than "C"; however, one final grade of "D" is permissible. A final grade of 3.0 or higher in all business courses completed and a B or higher at the time of application.

➤ **French National Honor Society**

- Blurb: The National Academic organization for high school French students. - **Rho Kappa National Social Studies Honor Society**

 - Application process will require a demonstration of civic engagement in school or community and applicants must have letter of recommendation from current faculty member
