1. Call to Order.

2. Review/Approval of the Minutes for board meeting held April 8, 2019. Minutes were approved as written.

3. Officers' Reports

- President's Report

Nannette Henderson provided an overview Open PTSO positions for the 2019/2020 school year. The PTSO needs an exceptional Education Liaison, the current Liaison is a senior parent. There are also Committee positions that need to be filled. Nannette also reviewed the PTSO calendar for the upcoming school year.

- Treasurer's Report

- Julie Hopkins reviewed the financial report (Report as of 5/31/19). No questions were brought to the floor.
- Ratification of email approval for STEP Team funding of \$218 for transportation for NVCC performance was held.
- Next school year the PTSO will probably spend more money with it being the second year for Principal Morris; this year is ending with a bigger surplus than expected.
- Mini Grant for teachers was discussed, it is currently about \$200. The idea of putting money into a foundation that offers large Grants, one that ensures it goes to our teachers was suggested. This will be looked into.
- Input was requested from committee chairs for next year's budget.

4. Committee Reports:

- ANGP. To date approximately 300 students bought tickets to attend. Tickets will be sold till midnight before graduation.
- Baccalaureate. There is a low attendance thus far. All slots in the SignUp Genius are filled, the event will be well supported. The Dress Rehearsal went well. An additional song has been added to the ceremony. A Senior Slide Show will be shown and Senior Art Work will be displayed.

- Beatification. Steve Waugh was unable to attend the meeting, Nannette Henderson gave the report on his behalf. Silverbrook Nursery is donating all the plantings. They will get to have their Silverbrook Signs on stakes placed on the grounds near the plantings and have a banner displayed by the stadium.
- Directory. It has been determined that the Directory has zero impact on boosting membership.
- Golf Tournament. The Golf Tournament is being held Monday, June 10th. The online Auction has so far raised \$2,500. The money raised will be split with the Boosters.
- Scholarships. There are four winners (names not available at this time).
- Social Media. The question was raised do we need a policy in place as to what is posted in Social Media. An open discussion took place. Nothing to date has happened where there has been an issue to address/resolve. The PTSO is just thinking forward, trying alleviate the potential of a problem. Anything posted currently doesn't need to go through a South County High School staff member/administrator. Should it be a Page versus a Group was discussed, and it was mentioned that the Craft Fair is a Page, whereas, the Military Connection is a Group.
- Staff/Teacher Appreciation. The Staff/Teacher Appreciation Luncheon was a success. Thirty students showed up to help with the luncheon, but Cassy wasn't expecting them and requested ideas on how to handle this next year if it happens again. It was discussed what involvement the students should have. There was plenty of food, more than needed.
- Teacher of the Year. Anne Baylor won Teacher of the Year. A plaque has been ordered and a brass plate. At the last Staff Meeting being held on June 13th the award will be presented. The PTSO is providing two cakes for the meeting.
- Website. The current Web Administrator is continuing in this position for the upcoming school year, but once she is gone the PTSO might look into a new program for managing the Website because the current program is complicated. Midway through the 2019/2020 school year the PTSO will consider looking into a new program.
- Craft Fair. The Craft Fair Chair is hoping to increase the budget line for it, the discussion will be taken offline.
- Need the following positions filled:
 - Honor Roll
 - Membership
 - Social Media
- Miscellaneous. Next school year hoping to get the PTSO Mosaic program in place in hopes of getting families/parents of other cultures more involved. An International Night that includes food and shows is something that was suggested in addition to what the school coordinates. A question was brought to the floor regarding DECA and if the PTSO can provide them with funding in the future. It was announced that there will be a new chair for DECA next school year.

6. Announcements/other

- Giant is ending its program where money goes to the local schools. SCHS brought in \$8,000 this school year.
- Scholarships was discussed and how much money should be given and how many students should be selected.
- Not sure if Golf Tournament will be held next school year.

- Option of Nighttime coffees with the principal is being considered, or possibly PTSO meetings only is enough.
